This letter is all about missions. Specifically, mission opportunities.

I serve on the Board of Directors of the Clarke College Alumni Association. My good friend Dewayne Tanton, also a Clarke graduate, has agreed to serve with me on the Missions Committee of the Board.

One of the most hallowed traditions we enjoyed at Clarke was its legendary emphasis on missions. It was part of the ambience, part of the college spirit. Student summer missions, North American missions, international missions -- we did them then and we have done them since then. Dewayne and I both went from Clarke to participate in summer missions in Montana, an experience that marked for me the beginning of my missions career.

VOLUNTEER MISSION SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS

Should you be planning to go on a volunteer mission trip, the Missions Committee asks you to be aware of the following requirements to qualify for financial assistance. Such assistance is given as funds allow.

- 1. Applicant must be a current, dues-paying member of the CCAA.
- 2. Applicant must have attended Clarke for at least one school year.
- 3. The application must be received no less than 90 days before the scheduled mission trip.
- 4. The mission trip must be sponsored by a sponsoring body, such as a Baptist church, a Baptist association, or a legitimate mission-sending agency. We require some sort of supporting documentation from that sponsoring body.
- 5. If for any reason the mission trip is cancelled, or the applicant is unable to go on the trip, the financial assistance given must be returned to the CCAA Board.
- 6. Financial assistance will only be granted to SBC-related mission trips in which the Clarke College alumnae is a mission team member.
- 7. The CCAA Board is requesting a summary of the mission trip after the mission team has returned from the mission field.
